



Guam-PIC Stipends, Benefits, and Resources

The annual internship stipend for both consortium sites is \$33,000. Interns will be employees of the agency at which they are primarily placed. All interns will receive comparable health benefits, as well as paid time off, through their employer. In addition, interns receive twelve paid Guam government holidays (please see the Guam Government Observed Holiday calendar for dates). PTO days and federal/state holidays count toward total hours. Questions regarding specific benefits packages can be directed to the employing agencies' Human Resources departments.

Guam-PIC interns have access to numerous resources. Funding for travel within the territory of Guam is provided for interns to complete required training experiences. Assessment and other training materials are provided by each training site, and additional materials that may be needed may be purchased using consortium funding with Training Committee approval. In addition to weekly didactic seminars and other professional trainings, interns will be given access to a psychology scientific literature database. Each intern additionally has access to administrative and IT support through their primary training site and through WICHE.
